Form B (rev. 6/08) must be accompanied by two checks, one for the bonus bid for the leasing unit and one check for \$30.00 to cover the application fee. All application fees are forfeited to the Trust Lands Administration. The minimum acceptable bid is **\$2.00 per net acre or fractional part thereof** unless otherwise noted. Each bid is for the first year of the lease.
