BITUMINOUS SANDS – ASPHALTIC SANDS LEASING UNITS

The lands listed below are available for lease under the bituminous sands – asphaltic sands (“tar sands”) lease category. As defined by administrative rule, R-850-22-200, the term “bituminous – asphaltic sands” means rock or sand impregnated with asphalt or heavy oil and is synonymous with the term “tar sands”.
