ADDITIONALLY, THE SUCCESSFUL LESSEE SHOULD BE AWARE THAT THE TRUST LANDS ADMINISTRATION WILL NOT CONSENT TO LEASE TERM OR ANNUAL RENTAL SUSPENSIONS ON LEASES WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY WITHIN EXISTING OR PROPOSED WSA'S BECAUSE OF RESTRICTIONS PLACED UPON ACCESS OR AVAILABILITY OF SURROUNDING BLM LANDS FOR LEASING AND/OR OPERATIONS.
